Good leaders have a refined ability to understand where and what to address or influence within, across, and outside of the organization, most obvious choices being:

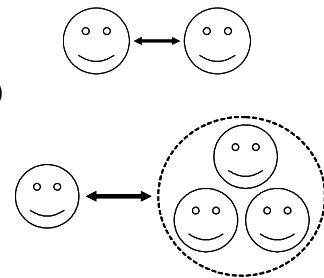
Intrapersonal (Self)

- Internal to one individual



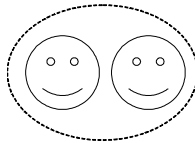
Interpersonal (Self & Other)

- Individual/Subgroup (Leader + a Subset of Direct Reports)



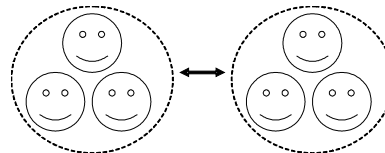
Intragroup:

- Inside/within within a group



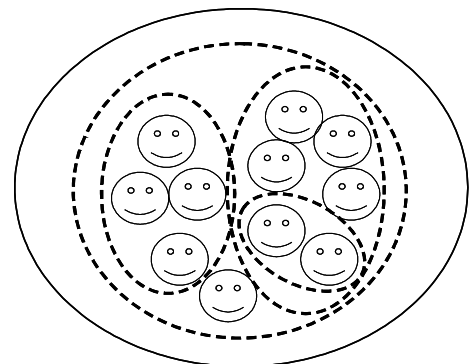
Intergroup (Number of Subgroups)

Environment

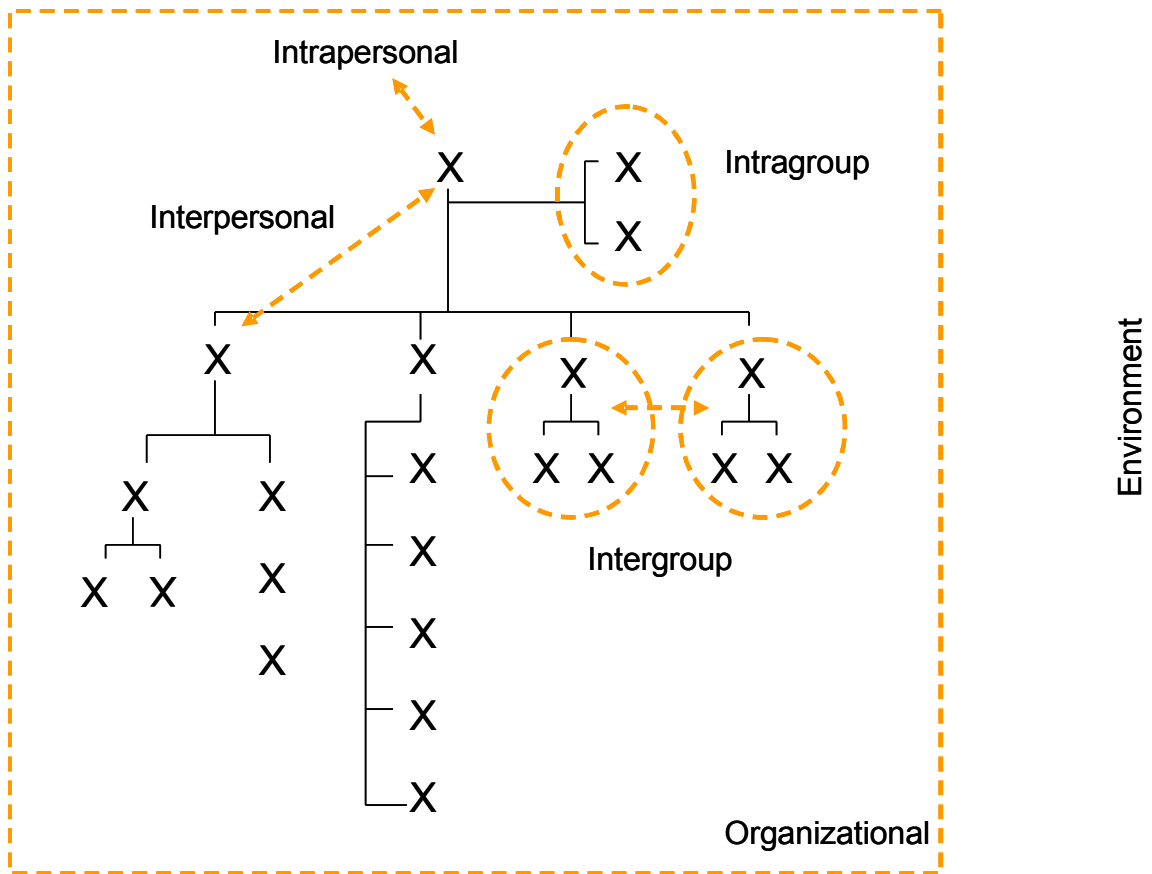
- Others external to the organization such as customers, competitors, local, state, national and/or international governments
